

Human Concern International (HCI SA) directly implemented projects/activities.

Human Concern International being a development organization carries out different activities and projects for the welfare of the needy people in Pakistan. Our main activities are focused on Education for children, basic medical facilities, skill development and helping the affected people with relief and rehabilitation activities. To achieve this objectives, usually HCI own staff directly implement the projects, in locations where HCI partners are active, and far from approach, the projects are implemented by the partners.

The projects and activities those are directly implemented by HCI own staff with locations and details are mentioned as follows:

Kashmir

Education

HCI all schools are running and providing education to more than 1270 students of the area.

From 1st June to 11th June 2018 examination was taken from play group to 7th class except 5th class where 5th class examination is taken by elementary board Muzaffarabad so 5th class first term examination is taken with 8th, 9th and 10th classes.

On 12/06/2018 schools are closed for summer vacation due to very hard weather in the area so government of AJ & Kashmir also announced to close all Govt. and private schools from 12th June 2018 to 31st July 2018.

On 19th July 2018 result of 10th class is announced, 40 students gave examination from HCI school system and 36 passed, the examination and result is 90%, 4 students are reappear in one or two subjects .

Among the passed students A grade are 6 and B grade are 30 students. Result was satisfactory.

9th class result is announced on 10th August 2018 and 62 students appear in the examination and 24 completely passed the examination while 38 students are reappear in one or two subjects.

The result of 9th class was very bad in whole board; most of the students are reappearing in Govt. schools as well as private schools.

After summer vacations schools and colleges are open on dated 1st August 2018 and classes are started in all schools.

Admission in first year up till now and more admissions are expected.

The first term examination of 5th, 8th, 9th, and 10th classes are taken from 13th to 26th of August 2018.

The monthly meeting is held of teaching staff and decisions are take for betterment of the education and HCI other activities.



On 14th August Pakistan Independence Day is celebrated in HCI Battlian school main hall and the children from HCI all schools participated in this function, guests of organizations are also participated in this function.

Students of HCI schools participated in the competition of speech, Naat and other, prizes are distributed among winners.

Uniform, books, stationary and shoes are provided to sponsor children of first year as other sponsor children have taken uniform books and shoes already.

Zabiha meat is distributed among children in Zabiha Eid, more than 700 shares are distributed.



Mother and Child Health care centre (MCH) Battlian AJK

HCI MCH is also working as usual and poor patients are treated here, school children and sponsor children families are also treated and free medicine is provided to all, poor patients are treated free of cost while other patients are provided 40% medicine and free checkup facility. HCI is trying to appoint a female MBBS doctor for MCH but MBBS doctors are not available in the area recently but some local female doctors are busy in education and will be available soon. More than 2000 patients are treated here on quarterly basis.



Hope Village Afghan Education program

Hope Village School was closed for summer vacation from 25th June to 1st September while other teaching staff has come to school regularly.

The new academic yare has been started from 1st September and students have been started their studies and that will be going up to 21th June 2019 Insha Allah.

School books have been distributed to the all students and stationary and uniform to the sponsors students only.

The Zabiha meat have distributed to the students and staffs in Eid Ul Adha.



The teachers' meeting was held on 16th August for the betterment of education system in Hope Village School and other activities.

The examination of uncompleted students (reappear in one or two subjects) has done on 28th August and the result has announced on 1st September.

The admission of new students has been started from 16th August.

School is starting by the assembly on 7:30 AM and there are six periods daily and every period is 40 minutes and the school is close on 12:00 PM.

Skill development centre for females in Punjab

Human Concern International is running a skill training centre in Faisalabad to support the poor females from low income families. This skill has provided training facilities to hundreds of young girls from low income families in professional cutting and stitching techniques. It is encouraging that majority of the females those got training from this centre are on jobs or having their own small business. The environment in the centre is professional and friendly and instructor works hard with the trainees girls.



Females from poor and low income families take keen interest in training classes and some of the females come with their work to the centre to furnish the task under the guidance of their teacher. Due to this centre some of the trained females easily find stitching work from the centre. On April 30, 2018 a course is completed and 17 females have successfully completed cutting, stitching and designing course from the centre, some of the female from this course have secured jobs in the garments factories and some of them works at their homes.

A new course has been started on May 16, and it is reported that 12 females have got admission in the new course.

Parents of the trainees are satisfied from training procedures and the centre environment.

Elders and local representatives, councilors of different areas approach HCI to establish such skill centre in other localities for poor and low income families.
